

DEAR EXECUTIVE BOARD MEMBER:

I am sure you will be happy to know that we have completed a Protestant Chapel and a Catholic Chapel at Massawepie for service to Camp Pioneer and Voyageur. These Chapels are located in outdoor amphitheatres and are divided into two parts: an 8 X 12 foot porch used as a worship center, and a 12 X 12 foot residence for Chaplains (when without family) with toilet and running water.

The Protestant Chapel will be dedicated in memory of Walter Sage Hubbell on Sunday morning, August 10th. This Chapel was financed by the gift of the Hubbell sisters in our 1951 Campaign.

The Catholic Chapel is in use, but will not be dedicated at this time. It may well become a memorial if a gift in the 1958 Campaign is made for that purpose. If so, the dedication will take place in 1959.

Both Catholic and Protestant Chaplains have expressed their pleasure at the facilities being provided. We will eventually set up similar facilities for two camps on the west side of Massawepie, and a single Jewish Service Center in the most effective possible location.

If you are planning to visit Massawepie this summer, we would be very happy to have you present at the dedication on August 10. Please let the Scout Office know if you wish motel accommodations in the neighborhood. Meals will be available at Massawepie.
