

# Mountain Fox

*For those scouts that have “been there- done that” at camp and that are looking for new adventures and challenges, this is what you need!*



Massawepie Scout Camps offers so many different activities during your weekly stay, it's hard to imagine that you want more, but this is what you've been looking for. You and other older, more experienced Scouts/Venturers (**age 14 or older**) from a variety of Troops/Crews, will form your own group and plan your activities with the help of a certified Voyageur Guide.

A typical stay starts with an overall orientation and group dynamics games to get everyone acquainted and to set the week's goals. Options include both day trips and overnight trips, by foot or afloat, taking place on our 3800 acre reservation's trails and ponds. Generally, we meet after breakfast each day and return back to base camp in time for supper at the dining hall. Choices of activities include canoeing, mountain biking, hiking, sailing, overnight mini-treks, or even going off our property and summiting one of the High Peaks. We traditionally participate in a white water rafting trip on Thursday on the challenging (Class III & IV rapids!) Black River followed by our own chicken bar-be-que.

## **IMPORTANT**

Scouts/Venturers participating in Mountain Fox need to be a Blue Swimmers at check-in and should bring proper equipment (see list on other side) with them to camp that will allow them to “Be prepared” for these activities.

There is an **additional program cost of \$99 per scout** DUE at the time of Class registration.

The program also will require an adult to accompany each group, with their Voyageur, on their daily activities. This does not have to be the same adult for each activity and the duty may be shared between participating units.
